

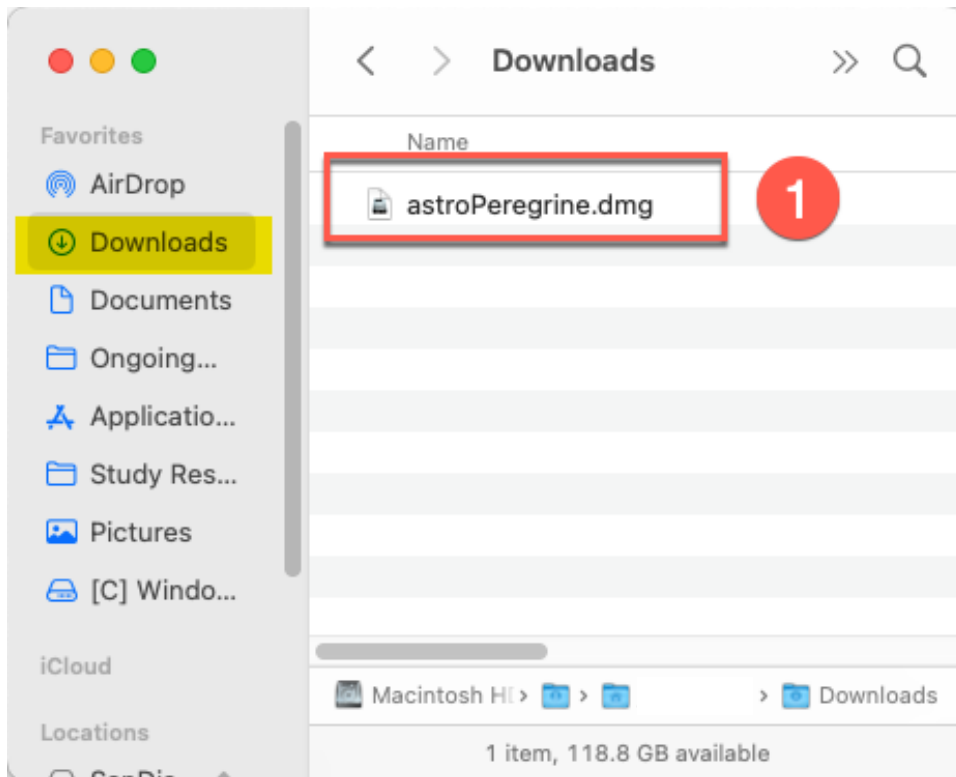


Installing astroPeregrine on your Macintosh

Successful astroPeregrine install

After you have downloaded the astroPeregrine installer, it will be placed in your **'Downloads'** folder (Macintosh ダウンロードフォルダ).

Here's what it looks like (I have removed all the other files for clarity's sake).



The installer's name is **'astroPeregrine.dmg'**

Install File Locations

There are two different locations used during the *astroPeregrine* installation. The two locations are:

Applications folder (アプリケーション フォルダ)

This is where you will install the astroPeregrine program.

Documents folder (ドキュメント フォルダ)

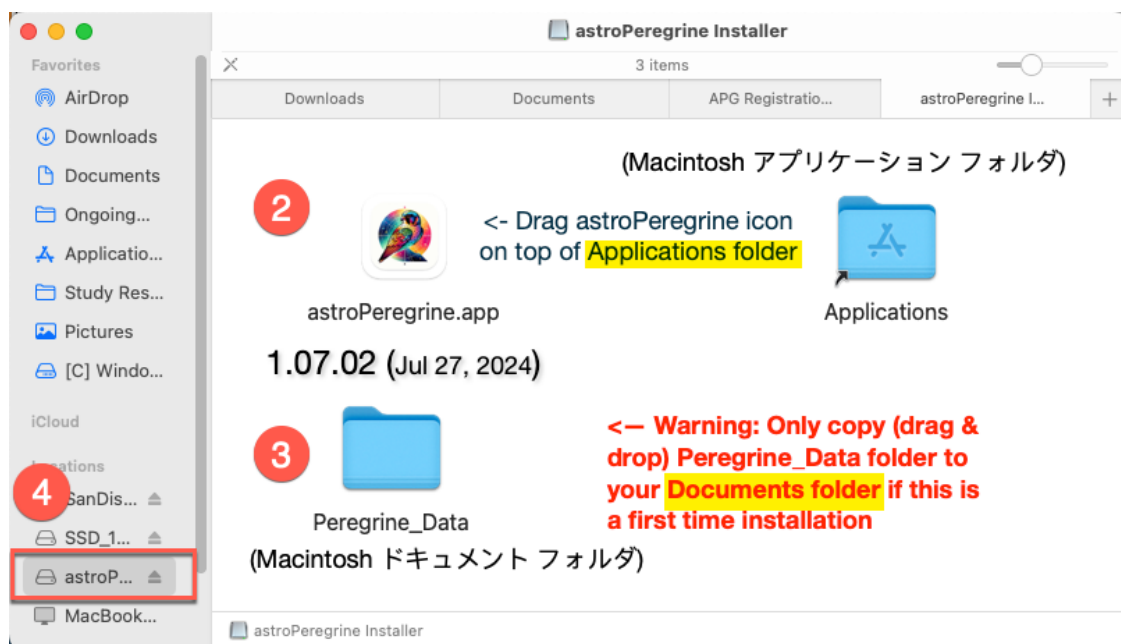
This is where you will copy the '**Peregrine_Data**' folder.

Install astroPeregrine

To have a successful astroPeregrine install, follow these steps **in exact order**.

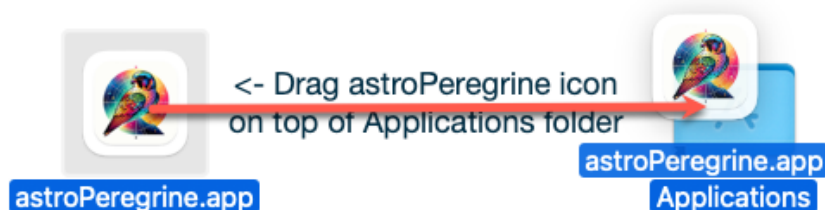
Step 1:

Double-click on the '**astroPeregrine.dmg**' installer. In a few seconds, the installer will open and look like this:



Step 2:

Using the computer mouse, *click and drag* the icon '**astroPeregrine.app**' over the '**Applications**' folder icon and release your mouse. (As in the picture below)



The **'astroPeregrine.app'** will be copied into your **'Applications'** folder.

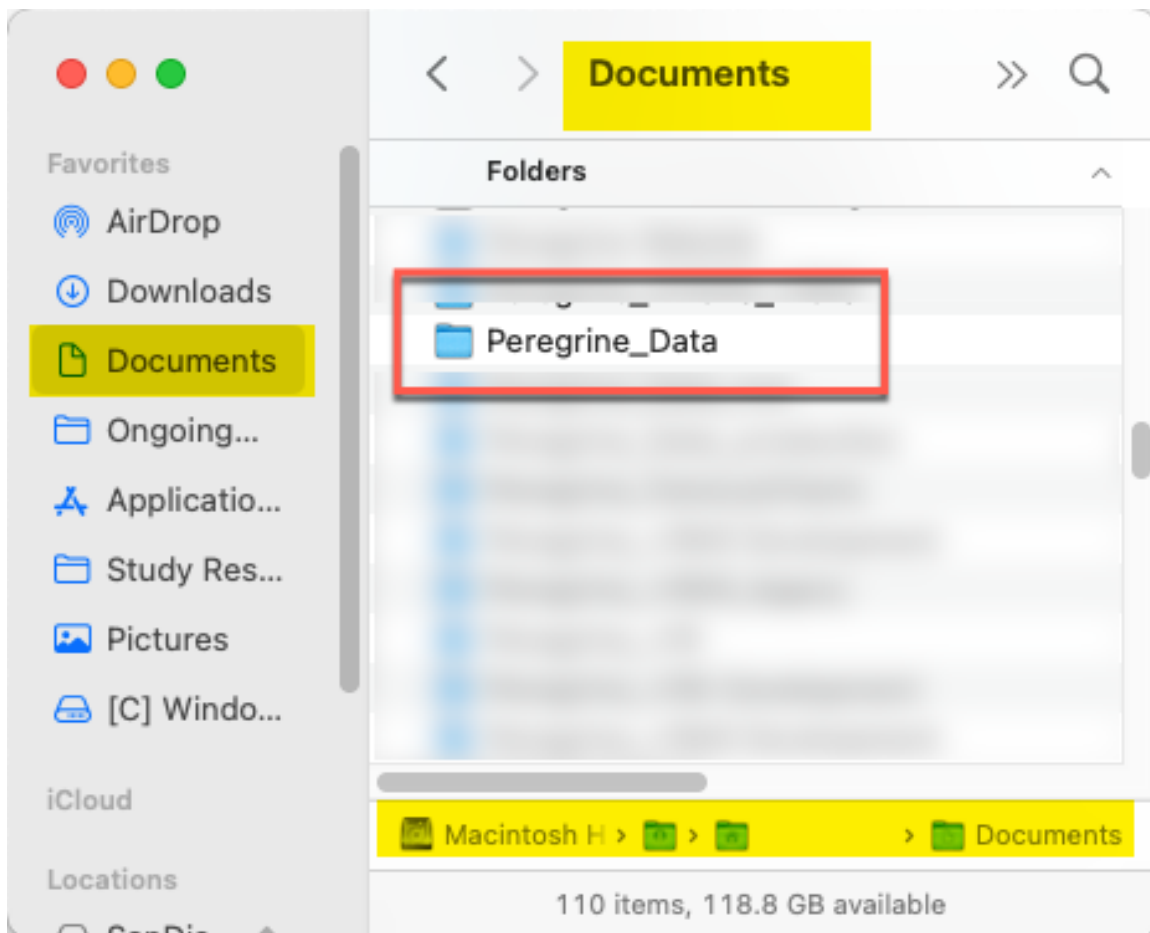
Open your **'Applications'** folder and scroll until you can see the **'astroPeregrine.app'**.

Step 3:

Now it is time to copy the **'Peregrine_Data'** folder into your **'Documents'** folder.

There are several ways to do this.

1. *Click and drag* into the **'Documents'** folder icon in the **'Favorites'** panel.
2. *Copy* (Cmd+C) the **'Peregrine_Data'** folder, and navigate to your **'Documents'** folder and *paste* (Cmd+V).
3. *Open* the **'Documents'** folder as a separate folder and *drag and drop* the **'Peregrine_Data'** folder into the **'Documents'** folder.



The easiest way is **#1**. *Click and drag* the '**Peregrine_Data**' icon over the '**Documents**' folder icon in the '**Favorites**' panel, then release your mouse.

- Open your '**Documents**' folder and scroll until you can see the '**Peregrine_Data**' folder.

Congratulations, you have successfully installed the astroPeregrine program and data folder! *Now you should eject the installer.*

Eject Installer

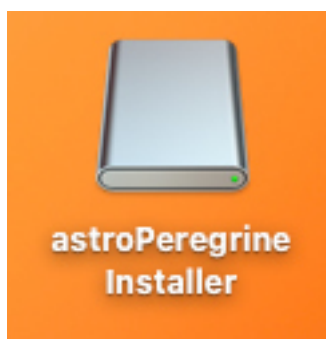
Step 4:

Once you have completed the installation, you will want to eject and close the installer.

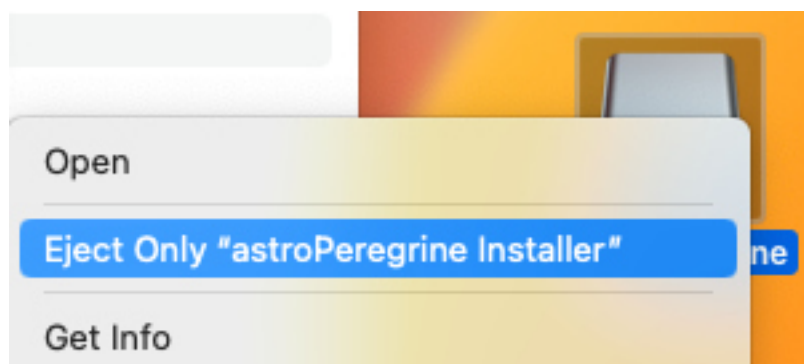
Below are instructions on several ways to eject the installer.

Method 1

- The installer icon will show up on your desktop as another drive. Here's what it looks like on my Macintosh desktop:



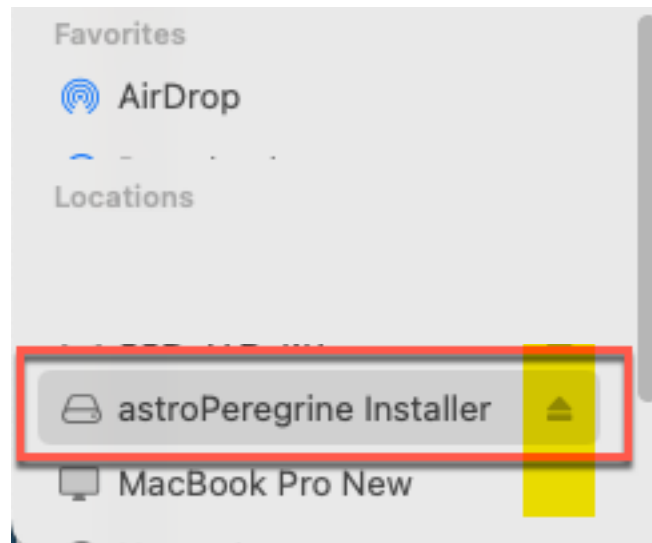
- To remove the installer, you can *right-click* with your mouse over the desktop icon and *select* '**Eject**' Only '**astroPeregrine Installer**':



Method 2

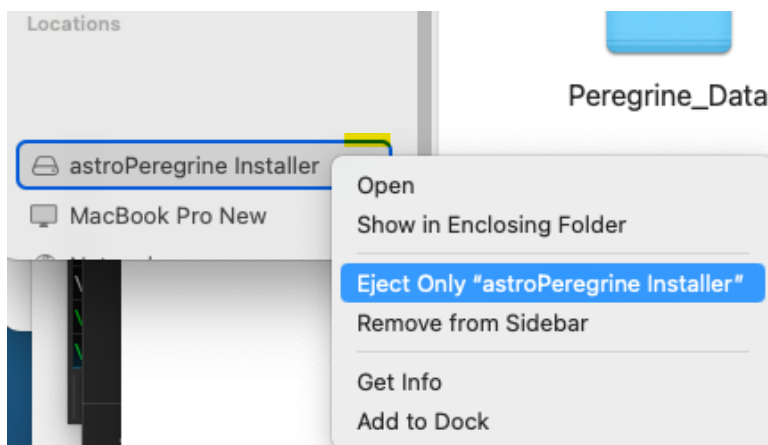
You can also access it in the left panel of any open folder. In my case, it looks like this:

- You can *right-click* with your mouse and *click* once on the little up-pointing arrow on the right side of the name.



Method 2b

- You can also right-click and hold your mouse over **'astroPeregrine Installer'** and select **'Eject'** Only **'astroPeregrine Installer'** like below.



You have now successfully removed the installer.

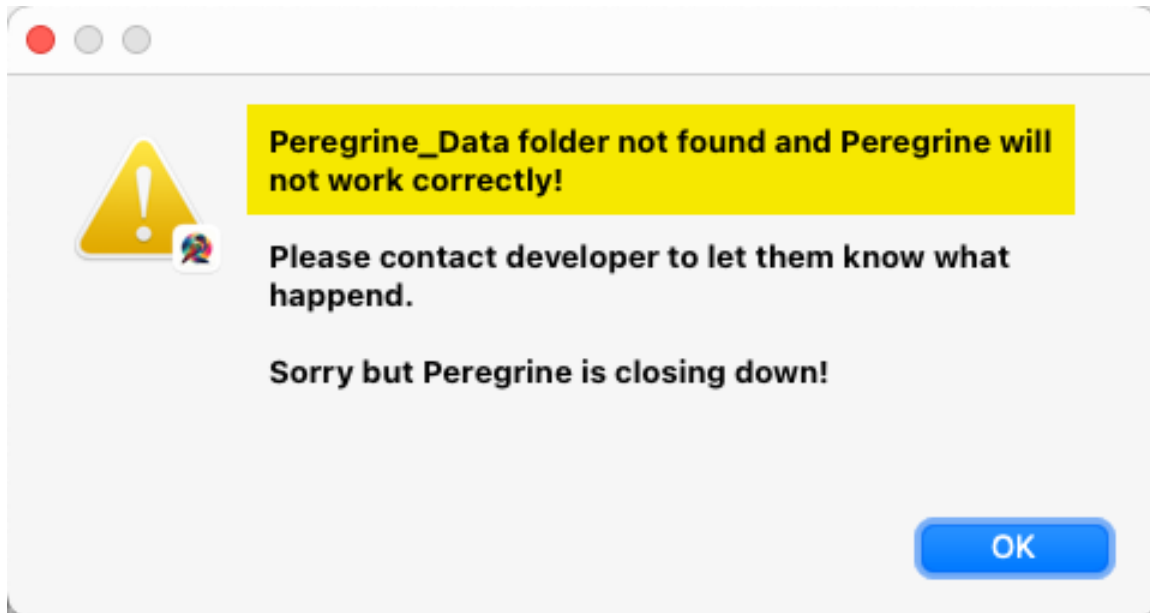
Once astroPeregrine has been installed, you can delete the installer from your **'Downloads'** folder.

Trouble Shooting

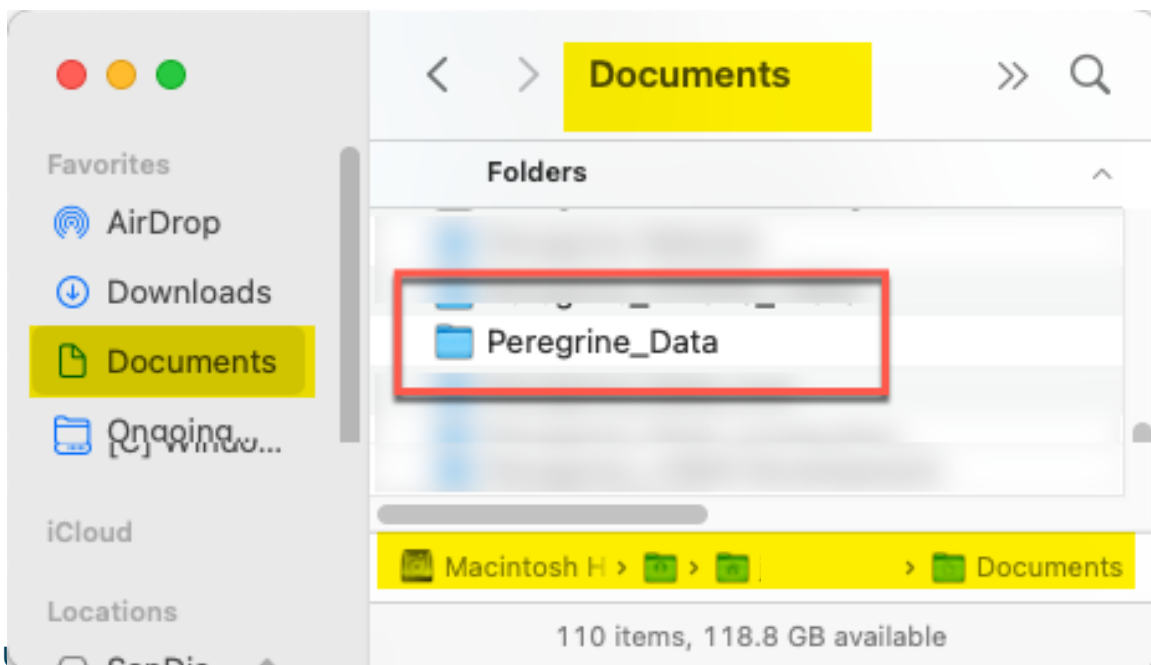
Sometimes Things Go Wrong

Sometimes, we copy the '**Peregrine_Data**' folder *to the wrong folder*.

- The '**Peregrine_Data**' folder **MUST** reside within the '**Documents**' folder. If the 'Peregrine_Data' folder has been installed incorrectly, you will see this error:



- This means you have installed the '**Peregrine_Data**' folder in the wrong location. *Drag* the '**Peregrine_Data**' folder into the '**Documents**' folder.



- Sometimes, the '**Peregrine_Data**' folder is in the '**Documents**' folder but accidentally copied into another folder *within* the '**Documents**' folder. You have to *drag* the '**Peregrine_Data**' folder into the '**Documents**' folder.
